Groups can Schedule H1N1 (Swine) Flu Vaccine Clinics

LIMA –The Allen County Health Department is available to provide H1N1 vaccine for groups of 20 or more. Businesses, organizations or churches that have a group of 20 or more people who would like to be vaccinated can call the Allen County Health Department at 419-228-4457 and ask to schedule an H1N1 clinic. The vaccine is recommended for everyone over 6 months of age and it is available to anyone who wants to be vaccinated. There is no charge for this service or the vaccine.

An H1N1 vaccination clinic for the general public will be held at the Delphos Senior Citizen’s Center on Friday, February 19 from 1- 3:00 p.m. In addition, weekday clinics continue at the Allen County Health Department, Monday – Friday, 8-9:00 a.m. and 3-4:00 p.m. No appointments are necessary and there is no charge for the vaccine.

“Influenza is unpredictable, and flu activity is expected to continue for months, caused by either 2009 H1N1 viruses or regular seasonal flu viruses,” says David Rosebrock, MPH, Health Commissioner. “The vaccine is the best protection against the 2009 H1N1 pandemic virus.”
