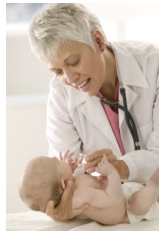

Children ages 11 to 17 are due for these
routine immunizations:

Tdap

Meningococcal (meningitis)

HPV (gardasil or cervarix)

Hep A (if not received prior)

As well as a review of their
childhood immunization record.
